Magoon Creek



Turn west off of US 31 on Red Apple Road, which is a blinker light on the south edge of Manistee. Red Apple will bend to the south and the entrance to Magoon Creek Natural Area is on the right (west). Total distance from US 31 is about 4.5 miles. The sign is back away from the road just enough that you will need to watch carefully for the entrance. If you reach Fox Farm Road, you have passed it! You may park at the entrance, or drive in about 0.5 mile to another parking area.





Question 1. At interpretive point 31 is an old foundation of a house. How many of its walls have no window or door openings?

Magoon Creek is managed by Filer Township: 231-723-3138. There is a flyer designed to go with the numbered posts which should be available in the white mailbox located at the edge of the parking area on Red Apple Road. There is a picnic pavilion, well water from a pump in summer, and latrines are available year-round. Magoon creek is unique in that there are several ecosystems to be seen within only about 100 acres.
